### Application for BACT (Program period: 2024.6.24~7.23)

#### Step 1

Once we receive the nomination notice from your university, we will tell you to proceed and submit the application document online and pay the program fee. Please note: the nomination letter will help us to identify your identity and the program fee that you need to pay.

\*IF you are not the student as stated above, please directly refer to Step 2.

#### Step 2

The application and payment website need to be through NTU Plus Academy, which is under the Office of International Affairs (OIA). Information on different summer programs will be kept updated by each college. For BACT summer program, it is our center that updates the information and the BACT information at OIA's website will be updated soon. Please check it around mid-December, 2023.

#### Step 3

**Do not directly pay the application fee of BACT (US\$ 300)** until we tell you to do so.

Write to Mr. Jack Hsu ([ntuciaee@ntu.edu.tw](mailto:ntuciaee@ntu.edu.tw)) first before you apply and pay the application fee (USD 300). Mr. Jack Hsu will ask you to submit an application form. Then, the College of Bioresources and Agriculture will make an assessment on your application.

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### Step 4

Mr. Jack Hsu will inform the applicants whether they are qualified and get accepted. Once accepted by email notice, we will tell you (the applicant) to go to NTU Plus Academy to start the online application. This is a process that you can eventually pay the fees and receive acceptance letter.

4.1 Write personal information → 4.2 Upload required documents → 4.3 Pay the application fee → 4.4 Wait for approval notice of the online system →

4.5 You will get notice and start to pay the program fee (if all required personal information and documents are complete) → 4.6 Payment successfully made → 4.7 Receive the acceptance letter, (which can be used visa application)

**\* NOTE:** The payment should be done before the end of March 31, 2024.

**\* NOTE:** If you do not complete all required information nor upload complete document, you will receive a notice from the system, which requests you to complete the unfilled blanks or upload the document that you missed. If the required information cannot be completed, you will remain at Step 4-5 and will not proceed to Step 4-6 & Step 4-7.

**\* NOTE:** The online application system at NTU Plus Academy will be open to all applicants around January 2024. Before that, if you have any questions about the BACT or LRWI, please contact us directly. We will do our best to answer your questions. This also means that you will only start to apply. and pay the application around January or February 2024.

### Application for LRWI (Program period: 2024.7.23~8.18)

With BACT, we also offer students *the Lab Research Work & Internship (LRWI)*. LRWI is a nearly one-month lab internship provided for BACT students only and the student has to be from our partner colleges which relate to Agriculture (as stated on page 1).

This year, the LRWI will **begin on July 23 and end on August 18 (departure day)**. Students MUST check the faculty member of the Departments of the College of Bioresources and Agriculture, and list five (5) of your favorite labs, and provide us with the name list of the 5 teachers (and their department names) based on your preferences. We will help you contact the faculty members one by one according to your preference and by doing so, we will help you to eventually find the teacher who can accept you as the intern.

Students are responsible for their own living expenses, including meals and transportation.</li> <li><b>All participants are responsible for:</b> their own personal expenses, and transportation from the airport to the accommodation hotel/dorm. When participating in the program in Taipei, <i>every two students of the same gender will share the same room with two separate single beds.
